

History of Service Excellence

The Jamaica Central Labour Organization (JCLO) has a proud heritage of providing seasonal workers to the United States for over 80 years. The organization has its roots in the British West Indies Central Labour Organization, which was established in 1943 by the Governments of various West Indian nations in answer to the US' call for farm workers during World War 2.

Initially, Jamaican and West Indian farm workers served primarily on sugar farms in Florida and Apple Orchards in New York, but this expanded over time with the addition of hospitality workers in 1972 and the establishment of the H-2A (Agricultural) and H-2B (Hospitality) visas in 1986.

By 2001, the organization became the Jamaica Central Labour Organization in keeping with its shifted focus solely on Jamaican workers. Today, the JCLO facilitates the employment of over 5,000 workers across 30 states with a network of 500 agricultural and hospitality employers who are comprehensively supported by a team of dedicated Jamaicans across the United States. You can find our workers proudly serving in nurseries, orchards, greenhouses, fruit and vegetable farms, sod and turf farms, hotels, restaurants and in landscaping companies across the United States.
